Contributions received are split equally between the Texas Credit Union League Political Action Committee (TCUL PAC) and the Credit Union Legislative Action Council (CULAC) to support state and federal pro-credit union candidates on a bi-partisan basis. State law requires political committees to report the following information for individuals whose contributions exceed \$50 during a reporting period: Name, Address, Occupation and Employer. Federal election law requires political committees to report the following information for individuals whose aggregate contribution is in excess of \$50 in a calendar year: Name and Address; and for contributions in excess of \$200 in a calendar year: Name, Address, Occupation and Employer. All information you provide will be kept confidential unless required by law. Contributions are strictly voluntary. Any suggested contribution amounts are merely guidelines and you are free to contribute more or less. You must be a United States citizen or a person lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States and you must be over the age of 18. **Corporate contributions are not permitted under state and federal law.** Contributions are not deductible for federal tax purposes.
